**Objectives of the Practice:**

**The Context:**

In today's world, education has become one of the most essential and expensive assets. Economically backward students require financial assistance to pursue their career. In such a scenario, scholarships come up as the most desired form of financial aid. This is because, unlike educational loans, you don't have to repay scholarships. The JSW also has the scheme for those family lost their sole bread earner for such students JSW compulsorily sanction scholarship and will give them till they complete their course. We have to locate such students through our mentor system

### 7.2.1 Best Practice 2 (2021-22)

**Title of the Practice:** Implementing Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

**Objectives of the Practice:**

1. To develop transformational change in rural development processes
2. To enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India
3. To create a virtuous cycle between society and an inclusive academic system

**The Context:**

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired by the vision of transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India. Our institution has registered for UBA and received Rs 50 000/- ( Fifty thousand only) from IRD, IIT Delhi on 9/9/2020

**The Practice:**

We have 50 students who are volunteers of UBA. The village survey of adopted five villages conducted. Our students discuss the farming, social issues, common basic requirements in village, the village infrastructure. Our students and the staff will discuss with the villagers. We educate the villagers to enrol for the state and central Govt benefits. Our lady staff discuss with the villagers in their home and give suitable solutions for their social problems also. Our local student volunteers communicate and help them. Our students give technical solutions for the villages facing infrastructure related issues. Gram Panchayat take guidance from our staff and students.

**Evidence of Success:**

The Gram Panchayat issued permission for Village survey and also extended their support. We have adopted 5 villages and villagers are getting our help.

**Problems Encountered and Resources Required:**

Villages need the guidance from our Engineering students and our highly qualified staff but our students also have their own academic pressure. So both stakeholders' meeting is limited.
